Focus on security and sustainability

Flexible building concept

The core of the school building is a large communal area at the centre of the school complex which is connected to all the main areas of the building. The auxiliary campus buildings have a similar structure to the main building. Individual study studios are grouped around a communal connecting area that serves as a multifunctional space. An open, flexible construction method with mobile separating walls means that the study studios can be extended as needed.

A large sports hall is available for physical education, with pitch markings for a variety of sports. A big kitchen built to US hygiene standards ensures that students will not go hungry.

Construction challenge: the stage tower

A highlight from a construction point of view is the theatre tower integrated into the communal area. The formwork for the curved tower has an inclined upper edge that required particular manual skill. The interior and external facades are clad with clay tiles. This rounded arrangement is unique in Germany and required a special building permit.
